- 1) 25% Need (explain anything both personally, family situation, # family members in college, medically etc. that adds to your financial need of the scholarship)
- 2) 30% Scholarship ability – GPA ACT/SAT scores, class rank, honors, awards, field of study etc
- 3) 15% Application - following directions, complete and detailed, etc
- 4) 15% Personal Qualities – Career plans, goals, leadership, teamwork, communication skills, etc.
- 5) 15% Community Involvement – any volunteer work, commitment to service etc.
- 6) Interview: Please dress for a professional interview. If you do not have interview cloths please contact us at the Nearly New. Good luck!

HS SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP RULES

1. Only students who resided within the Ennis school district area at the time of high school graduation are eligible. (Students may have attended a different high school.)
2. Applications for scholarships must be fully completed and returned to the MVWC Scholarship Committee before any consideration can be given by the committee.
3. All scholarships are made on the basis of numerous criteria-including the student's application, academic ability and record, financial need, involvement in school and community activities, and a student's personal statement or accompanying letter.
4. All scholarships must be used for the specified year (2017-1018)
5. Scholarships are payable directly to the school, in the student's name, to be used toward tuition, fees and books. Checks are sent to the school's financial office and must be endorsed by the student for deposit to the school.
6. Scholarships will be paid in August. If the student does not enroll in school, the check must be returned to the Madison Valley Woman's Club.
7. Scholarship awards will only be made public after all recipients have been notified and the membership of the Madison Valley Woman's Club has been notified.
8. Any recipient of a scholarship may, in the future, apply to the MVWC Scholarship Committee for an Alumni Scholarship.
9. When applying for a scholarship, return the completed application and a letter with any supporting information that would show financial need and general merit. Be certain to include all required information and copies of documents as listed on the application form.
10. All applications must be typed (with the exception of filling in blanks. You must use the Madison Valley Woman's Club scholarship format.
