**MADISON VALLEY WOMAN'S CLUB**  
**NON-TRADITIONAL-ADULT STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIP RULES**

1. Applicants must reside in the Ennis School District, but are not required to be graduates of Ennis High School.
2. "non-traditional student" is one who: may not have started college directly from high school; may have started, dropped out and would like to return; may have earned an Associate's Degree and now would like to earn a 4-year degree or get training in another field; may desire to attend a Vo-technical, non-traditional school, trade school {beauty, barber, electronics, etc.}; may be a parent who now has time to go back to school themselves; may be a senior citizen who still has a dream to go to or finish school; may be a home-schooled student.
3. All applications must be completed and returned to the MVWC Scholarship Committee before the committee can give any consideration to your application.
4. All scholarships are made on the basis of numerous criteria including: student's application, academic ability and record, financial need, community involvement, your letter.
5. All scholarships must be used for the specified year (2017-18)
6. Scholarships are payable directly to the school, in the student's name, to be used toward tuition, fees, and books. Checks are sent to the school's financial office and must be endorsed by the student, for deposit at the school.
7. If the scholarship awardee does not attend school, the check must be returned.
8. A recipient of this scholarship may apply to the MVWC Scholarship Committee for another non-traditional scholarship for another school year.
9. The completed application must be returned with a short letter to show any supporting information that you believe would show the committee your financial need and general merit-such as approximate school costs, living expenses, etc., activities and work experiences.
10. All applications must be typed and all instructions followed in order to be considered.
